Fall Meeting October 24-25, 2014 Mount Pleasant

On October 24-25, 2014, the Walter Prescott Webb Historical Society assembled in Mount Pleasant for the annual Fall Meeting. During the meeting, Webb Society chapters, from all over Texas, explored the rich heritage of one of Texas' great small towns. Participants enjoyed hands-on activities at the historic Concord Missionary Baptist Church and Cemetery including learning about bee keeping, Dutch oven cooking, playing horseshoes, and taking a tour of the historic cemetery. Participants then enjoyed a home cooked mean and presented their chapter reports. Next, the Webb members enjoyed a presentation by Dr. Walter Buenger of Texas A&M University on the history of East Texas. The evening concluded with the presentation of the TSHA Exemplary Service Award to Sponsor, Garna Christian of the University of Houston-Downtown, for over 35 years of dedicated service to the TSHA and the Walter P. Webb Historical Society.

Saturday's events began at the Mid-America Flight Museum, where Webb members received a behind-the-scenes tour and viewed historic airplanes, which are uniquely still in use. Participants then traveled to Pittsburg, visiting two locations of the Northeast Texas Heritage Museum. At the Heritage Farmstead Museum, participants viewed a historic home and enjoyed learning about life on a 1800s era farm. Participants then visited the Railroad Museum, where they viewed a collection of railroad memorabilia, a small art collections, and a replica of the Pittsburg Airship, which is thought to have flown before the Wright Brothers successful historic flight. A very special thank you to the Webb Society chapters and sponsors from Jacksonville and Northeast Texas Community College for making this Fall Meeting a success.
